Field News—Budapest, Hungary

It's our 13th year here on Team Hungary and how rich and full those years have been. Since moving to Budapest, I now have an amazing family – a wife and 3 beautiful children. God has been so very faithful to us. The team life and work of God under Pastor Kende is amazing and such a joy to be a part of. I often consider what an honor it is to know and to serve with so many amazing, spiritually minded grace believers. The ministry in Hungary has such great effect and momentum in so many areas and ways. People are being reached and disciplined and we are so thankful to be a part of this work of God.

If the only thing I did in Budapest was to teach in the Bible college, it would all be worth it. I have taught over 20 semesters; each class has been a treasure in His word, His presence, His mind, and His pleasure. Many students have walked the aisle on graduation day; many have found faithful ministries here in Budapest while others have heard the call to distant mission fields.

When I think of our little school, GGIS, across the tram tracks, nestled behind the trees, I think of a place where quiet miracles take place on a daily basis. Every morning in every grade, K through 12, the opening class is the Bible class. Each teacher with the shared hope, prayer and burden for Christ's life to be imparted and "rhemas" to be born in the hearts of each child and teenager. With about 40% from China, many from Korea and others from all across the globe, we truly have amazing ministry opportunities into their lives and families. God brought them here not only for an excellent education, but to find Christ personally.

In addition to the Bible classes, as the Chaplain in the school, I meet one-on-one with all the high school students through the year. In those special times I get to share with those who are not yet believers and build up those who are. They always open right up and often I have been able to lead many in a prayer of salvation. It's amazing how many come into our school having never heard about the Gospel of grace and leave as believers in Christ.

About 6 years ago we started a new church plant in the Buda side. It has been my privilege to pastor this small, growing congregation. To sense and watch the work of God in peoples lives is amazing.

After summer travels we are refreshed and excited to be back on the field with our hands to the plough. We were so blessed at our annual Hungarian conference, with Pastor Schaller joining us for a few days. That week is always a special, relaxed time with the Hungarian Body here. We look to the field here in Hungary with a fresh vision. We started up the Erd Bible study again – 26 adults came with 4 first time visitors! We are picking up with the Budakezsi Bible study, too. These house to house studies are such special times. The momentum is growing; what an amazing church and what a special work of God we are part of.
